### **PARENT & STUDENT NOTICE: Livestreaming of Classes and Student Activities**

**Livestreaming Program**: As a result of the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic and related issues, the South Fork School District is implementing a livestreaming program whereby students can be remotely connected to the live classroom. This livestreaming program will allow students to attend remotely at the same time when these classes are being held at the School. Thus, remote students will be able to interact with their teachers and classmates. Further, teachers and other educational staff members may interact with remote students on a one-on-one or small group basis. Finally, teachers or other educational staff may also interact with students from a location other than the teacher's classroom. The livestreaming sessions may include both (1) classroom attendance and related academic instruction or guidance, and (2) other student activities. The livestreaming program may be used throughout the 2020-2021 school year on a continuous or periodic basis.

**IMPORTANT NOTE**: Due to student record laws and privacy considerations, parents and students should understand that any livestreaming sessions and interactions are meant to be viewed by only students and the student's parent or guardian. Recording livestreamed sessions is prohibited. Therefore, steps and precautions should be taken to ensure that no third parties have access to the livestreaming video or audio at any time. Accordingly, you should ensure that your student is accessing the District's livestreaming on a secure and protected wifi network or device. Further, except when no other option exists, your student should not use a public wifi network or device, even if the network or device may have a password or other security measures. If you or your student permits or otherwise allows any third party to view or record the livestream from the District, the school reserves the right to revoke synchronous learning privileges in which case the student will need to make arrangements to receive materials from the teacher directly.
