E-Learning Day in lieu of Emergency Day

Expectations and Procedures for Jr. High and High School

On Emergency Days during the 2024-25 school year, whether called in advance or day-of, South Fork JH/HS will conduct E-Learning Days.

It is understood that in such circumstances Students and Staff members will be working from home and are not required/nor expected/nor encouraged to be present in the school building.

1. The JH/HS will run on a 12:15 Class Schedule along with advisory time in the afternoon.

2. Students will be expected to log onto their teachers' google meet at the designated times for each class period. Students who are unable to log on are required to make contact with that teacher.
3. Teachers will take attendance for each period.
4. Teachers are expected to teach a mini-lesson or otherwise engage in content related material in each class period.

5. Teachers are also expected to post an assignment on Google Classroom for students to complete and submit.
6. Students are expected to attend class in the morning and work on assignments in the afternoon.
7. Staff members are expected to be available remotely throughout the day to assist students as needed for additional support and intervention.
8. Staff members need to establish and review these expectations and procedures in advance with each of their classes to ensure students know what is expected of them in the event of an emergency day/remote learning day.
